**Warrant Arrest** – On Thursday evening, August 31<sup>st</sup> at approximately 11:15 p.m., an officer was conducting RADAR operations in the 15400 block of NW Military Highway, when the officer observed a vehicle exceeding the posted speed limit. The officer conducted a traffic stop on the vehicle and upon researching the driver of the vehicle, it was determined the driver possessed an active arrest warrant for ‘Failing to Stop and Give Information Over \$200’. The driver was taken into custody for the warrant and transported to the Bexar County Detention Center for processing.

**Assault Family Violence - Strangulation** – On Sunday morning, September 3<sup>rd</sup>, at approximately 2:00 a.m., an officer was conducting business patrols in the 3400 block of Paesanos Parkway when the officer observed a vehicle pull up in front of him. The officer observed two occupants inside the vehicle who appeared to be arguing. The officer made contact with the occupants who were in a dating relationship and through the officers investigation, learned the passenger had physically assaulted the driver. The passenger in the car was placed into custody for the felony charge and transported to the Bexar County Detention Center for processing.

**Assault** – On Tuesday afternoon, September 5<sup>th</sup> at approximately 1:00 p.m., an officer was dispatched to a location in the 3200 block of North Loop 1604 for an assault report. The complainant related they had witnessed an employee assault another subject a week prior and wanted to report the assault on behalf of the victim. This case referred to criminal investigations.

**Theft** – On Thursday afternoon, September 6<sup>th</sup>, at approximately 4:30 p.m., an officer was dispatched to a residence in Bentley Manor for a theft report. The complainant related they had received a call from a purported attorney who was requesting money for a relative who had been involved in an accident and was currently in jail. The resident collected a large sum of money and left money for the unknown subject at a disclosed location. A few hours later, the purported attorney called the resident a second

time, requesting additional money. Officers attempted to setup on the location in order to arrest the suspects when they arrived to collect the additional money, however after several hours passed, the suspects failed to return. This case referred to criminal investigations.

***Burglary of Motor Vehicle x2*** – On Wednesday evening, September 6<sup>th</sup> at approximately 9:30 p.m., officers were dispatched to a business location in the 3600 block of Paesanos Parkway for a pair of vehicle burglaries. Upon arrival, the complainants of both vehicles related upon exiting the location, they observed damage to door windows on their vehicles and property appeared to be missing. This case referred to criminal investigations.

***Driving While Intoxicated*** – On Wednesday evening, September 6<sup>th</sup> at approximately 11:00 p.m., an officer was dispatched to the 16800 block of NW Military Highway for a crash report involving two vehicles. During the crash investigation, the driver of one vehicle displayed signs of intoxication. After subsequent investigation, the driver was detained and transported to the Bexar County Detention Center where the officer was granted a warrant to obtain blood from the driver. Upon completion of the warrant, custody of the driver was transferred over to Detention Center personnel.
