Forgery – On Tuesday afternoon, September 12th, at approximately 12:30 p.m., a Shavano Park resident entered city hall to file a forgery report. The complainant related they had mailed a check to a San Antonio area business the day before. The complainant related on this date, their financial institution called to notify the complainant, an unknown person attempted to cash a check from the complainant and the check appeared to have been altered. The complainant confirmed with the financial institution, the check in question was not written for the amount altered on the document. This case referred to criminal investigations.

Theft – On Tuesday evening, September 12th at approximately 6:00 p.m., an officer was dispatched to a Shavano Park residence for a theft report. The complainant indicated they had received a phone call from a subject purporting to be law enforcement, saying the complainant had failed to appear in court and because of this, there were fees assessed against the complainant and the subject demanded payment to avoid arresting the complainant. The complainant proceeded to send the subject a partial sum of money through a cash transfer app. After receiving the money, the subject then demanded additional funds be transferred. The complainant indicated they then realized the phone call was a scam, ended the call and contacted the police and their financial institution. This case forwarded to criminal investigations.
