Driving While Intoxicated – On Monday morning, September 18th at approximately 5:30 a.m., officers were dispatched to a residence in the 100 block of Warbler Way for a report of a naked male in the area. While enroute to the call, officers were informed the subject was observed entering into a vehicle and driving off. As officers arrived in the general area, they observed the vehicle described by witnesses, turn onto NW Military Highway and begin to drive erratically. An officer conducted a traffic stop and the driver, who was in fact naked, displayed signs of intoxication. The driver failed a series of Field Sobriety Tests and was transported to a facility for a test of their breath. The results of the test indicated a breath alcohol level exceeding the state threshold of .08. The driver was then transported to the Bexar County Detention Center and booked for DWI.

Forgery – On Tuesday afternoon, September 19th, at approximately 1:30 p.m., an officer was dispatched to a local business in the 4400 block of Lockhill Selma for a Forgery report. The complainant indicated a former employee is suspected of taking business checks from the location and fraudulently passing the checks at an area financial institution. This case referred to criminal investigations.
