***Unauthorized Use Motor Vehicle (UUMV)*** – On Monday afternoon, November 6<sup>th</sup> at approximately 1:15 p.m., an officer conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle for failing to display a front license plate, in the 3800 block of DeZavala Road. Upon conducting a registration check of the vehicle, the officer discovered the vehicle had been reported stolen on November 2<sup>nd</sup> with the San Antonio Police Department. The driver was taken into custody without incident and transported to the Bexar County Adult Detention Center and booked for the above listed criminal charge. Criminal investigations will be conducting a follow-up investigation into the incident.

***Fraud*** – On Wednesday afternoon, November 8<sup>th</sup> at approximately noon, an officer was dispatched to a business in the 4400 block of Lockhill Selma for a fraud report. The complainant related they were notified by their financial institution of a credit card transaction occurring on their account, on two different occurrences, in an amount totaling over \$20,000. The complainant indicated they did not have any knowledge, nor did they authorize any purchases in those amounts. This case referred to criminal investigations.
