CARLETON ROCKWOOD CULVERT REPLACEMENT

As you are aware, the Village of South Rockwood has been working on replacing the culvert on Carleton Rockwood Road. Springline Excavating, LLC was the contractor awarded the Culvert Replacement Project and Hutch Paving was awarded the Asphalt Paving Project.

Tentative Work Schedule (Weather Permitting):

- On October 27-31 the contractor will remove approximately 300 by 22 feet of existing concrete pavement. Following that the concrete contractor will install the forms to pour the concrete pavement. This will take approximately two (2) weeks. This will not affect any resident driveway.
- On October 30, 2023, Hutch Paving will start milling the asphalt section of road from the culvert concrete area to Brandon Road, this will take approximately one (1) week. The residents will still be able to access their driveways.
- On the week of November 06, 2023, Hutch Paving will start paving the milled section. This work is expected to take approximately one (1) week. Expect up to eight (8) hours delay to get to the driveway as asphalt pavement needs time to cure.
- The project is scheduled to be completed by the end of November.

Dust Control

The Contractor will do his best to control dust as much as possible; however, this will be an active construction zone, and dust will exist and should be expected.

Sprinkler Systems

If you have a sprinkler system, to prevent any damage, we ask that you mark or flag where sprinkler systems may be located within the right-of-way (between the road and sidewalk). If sprinkler systems are accidentally damaged, the Contractor will replace as a part of this project. We request as soon as you notice the sprinkler systems have been reinstalled and are ready for use to turn the sprinkler system on to confirm there are no leaks present. It is also recommended that you winterize your system when you are done using the system for the season as water can freeze that is left in the lines over the winter months causing damage to the lines. It is important that any construction-related problems be identified and reported prior to the project being closed out at the end of this construction season.

Restoration

Upon completion of the project, all disturbed areas will be replaced with topsoil and seed. The Contractor will be responsible to maintain restored areas until vegetative growth has been established.

Garbage Pick-Up/Mail and Parcel Delivery

Your garbage pickup will remain uninterrupted during construction. We ask that you place your garbage in your normal location for pick-up. The Contractor will move your garbage at 7am on pick up days to the side of the street that is open to traffic. Once picked up, all empty cans will be returned to your normal location. It is recommended that you place your address on any garbage bins that you may have. Mail delivery and parcel delivery will not be interrupted at any time.

Working Hours

Typical working hours will be from 7:00am to 7:00pm Monday through Friday, with the potential of work taking place on Saturdays. It is possible that sawcutting of joints immediately following the placement of concrete may have to take place during evening hours or during a weekend.

We are nearing the finish line. We apologize for any short-term inconvenience this may cause; we hope you will share our enthusiasm for all the improvements to infrastructure in in The Village of South Rockwood.
