RULES FOR BURNING AS FOLLOWS:

- **No burning on construction sites.**
- **No burning of leaves or grass clippings.**
- Open burning only allowed by permit, issued by Springfield Fire Department
- Materials burned must be from the permit site only
- No burning along roadways
- No flammable liquids shall be permitted to ignite the fire (i.e. gasoline, kerosene, fire starter)
- Fire must be attended by an adult at all times
- Must be at least 25 feet from a structure or combustible material
- Must have a fire extinguisher (4-A rating or better) or other extinguishment material ready for immediate use
- No fuel area greater than 6 feet in diameter
- Campfires are allowed in the township without a permit with size of 3' X 3' and 2' in height. Extinguished by 11:00 PM

In accordance with Springfield Township Code of Ordinances, Chapter 16, Section 16-57 through Section 16-63 and Springfield Township Code of Ordinances, Chapter 2, Division 2.

Materials Permitted to Burn

- Brush, tree trimmings, shrubbery and other wood materials

Materials that are Prohibited to Burn

- Plastic/Rubber, tires, Petroleum or any product emitting black smoke
- Treated Lumber (Wolmanized or railroad ties)
- Garbage, refuse, trash, rubbish or material giving off foul or offensive odors
- Manufactured Building Products/OSB Structure Board
