

# Sutherlin, Land of Opportunity

The Sutherlin mural that has stood at exit 135 from I-5, has been transformed from an unassuming sign into a substantial piece of artwork that is a message of "Welcome to Sutherlin, Land of Opportunity." Local artist and craftsman, Adam Sarnoski of Cooper Creek Creative, dedicated a year of his time and talent in creating the new mural. Throughout the process he had to deal with many delays brought about by problems with the shipping of needed materials, finding a designer to complete the project and his own challenges in achieving his vision for the mural. In what began as a conversation with city staff and receiving approval from the City Council, who made the restoration of the mural a priority, Adam took on the request to redesign the original logo. After 300 hours of fabricating the logo into a 3-D design, painting it in three layers of color gradations to create depth, restoring the monument that had been damaged by the elements and painting the steel cut letters created by Stephen Montpas, it was ready for installation. The final addition will be the halo lighting which will encircle the lettering and enhance its impact to those entering Sutherlin, the Land of Opportunity.



This has been a career changing moment for Mr. Sarnoski. He will be making the transition from chiropractor to now expanding his other business and passion of designing signs and more. He is very pleased with the outcome of the mural and feels that his contributions to the community are through his work. "This is my town." Adam Sarnoski



### Christmas Trees Light Up Central Park

The multi-use stage that is now the centerpiece of Central Park will now provide a platform for the much anticipated return of the 50' Christmas tree. The stage, which was the anchor for the summer festivities, will anchor the tree with a base and pole built by Great Northern Trailer Works of Sutherlin. The pole for the 50' tree is sectioned into eight pieces that can be raised and lowered like a flag pole to aid in the maintenance of the 48 strands of lights that each contain 200 individual bulbs. The trio of trees will once again adorn the park with their impressive heights of 18', 23' and 50', surrounded by gifts that glow with the promise of the holiday to come. There will also be a 30' lighted tree installed at the Visitor's Center.



The installation will take place after the Thanksgiving weekend and the star on top of the 50' tree will be the beacon to light the way to Christmas in Sutherlin.
