

Municipal General Election 2021 Information

All active registered voters will be mailed a ballot on October 12th-26th. Logic and Accuracy will be conducted October 8th at 9am in the Clerk-Auditor's Office. The 2021 regular general election will be conducted primarily by mail; in-person voting will be available from 7 am-8pm on Election Day, November 2nd and during Early Vote October 19th-29th from 8am-5pm. There will only be one polling location located at the County Building 147 E Main St. Vernal, UT.

The voter registration deadline is October 22nd, eleven days before the day of the election. An individual with a disability who is not able to vote a manual ballot by mail may obtain information on voting in an accessible manner from the county's website, by contacting the county clerk, or by reviewing the information included with a ballot mailed to the voter.

Ballot drop boxes will be available from October 12th – November 2nd in the following locations; 204 E 100 N, Vernal outside of the Uintah County Library, or inside the Uintah County Building. Ballot Drop Boxes will be open until 5 pm except on November 2nd, they will be open until 8 pm. An Audit will be held November 9th at 10 am in the Clerk-Auditor's Office.
