

## NOTICE TO BIDDERS

SEALED PROPOSALS for the PERKIOMEN CREEK STREAMBANK STABILIZATION AND HABITAT IMPROVEMENT PROJECT at CAMELOT PARK will be received by Upper Hanover Township in Montgomery County, until **11:00 AM on December 22, 2023**, at which time the bids will be opened and read aloud. The Board of Supervisors will consider the proposals and tentatively award at their regularly scheduled meeting on **January 9, 2024**.

The objectives of our project are to reduce sediment and associated pollutant/contaminant loads, improve water quality and enhance aquatic habitat conditions within the Perkiomen Creek. These objectives will be accomplished by installing strategically designed streambank stabilization and habitat improvement structures within an approximate 1/3-mile reach of the Perkiomen Creek located within Camelot Park.

A **mandatory** Pre-Bid conference will be held on **Tuesday December 5, 2023 at 11:00 AM** at the Upper Hanover Township Public Works facility, located within Camelot Park, at 1124 Church Road, East Greenville PA, 18041.

Proposals shall be accompanied by a bid security in the amount of ten percent (10%) of the total amount of the proposal. Proposals shall be effective for 90 days from the date of opening. The successful low bidder will be required to provide a 100% performance bond or certified check, a 100% payment bond or certified check, a workman's compensation affidavit and a certificate of insurance naming Upper Hanover Township and LTL Consultants as additional insureds, all within 10 days after the contract is awarded.

Proposals must be made upon the forms furnished by Upper Hanover Township. Upper Hanover Township reserves the right to waive any non-material defects or irregularities in the bid, and to reject any or all bids or portions thereof. Upper Hanover Township, in accordance with Title VI of the U.S. Civil Rights Act of 1964 and Parts 21 and 23 of 49 C.F.R., notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that MBE/WBE will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and that no person will be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, sex or national origin in consideration for an award.

**Actual work on the project cannot start prior to July 1, 2024 and is to be fully completed by July 31, 2024.** The Township will determine and award a bid in the best interest of the Township. Liquidated damages apply at a rate of \$400.00 per calendar day.

Proposals must include the Publics Works Employment Verification Form completed by the Bidder.
