AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 460-8.B TO ESTABLISH THE INTERSECTION OF JAMES ROAD, ROSE DRIVE, AND VINE DRIVE AS REQUIRING VEHICLES TO STOP FROM EVERY DIRECTION; SETTING FORTH AN EFFECTIVE DATE, A REPEALER CLAUSE, AND A SEVERANCE CLAUSE

It is hereby ORDAINED by the Upper Hanover Township Board of Supervisors as follows:

1. Ordinance 460-8.B is amended by the addition of the following intersection to the list of all-way stops:

James Road at its intersection with Rose Drive and Vine Drive.

2. This ordinance is effective five days after adoption.
3. Should this ordinance be found inconsistent with any existing Township ordinance, the existing ordinance is repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
4. Should a court of competent jurisdiction find any portion of this ordinance to be invalid, then to the extent possible, the invalid portion shall be severed from the remainder, which shall continue in full force and effect.
