

# Vestal Historic Preservation Commission

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## Old Business:

- M. Hadsell has applied to the William G. Pomeroy Foundation for grants to replace the historic canal markers located at Front Street and the Rivercrest location.
- The Lustron house located at 2448 Vestal Parkway East is for sale. The property was designated as a local historic landmark in 2012 and is included on a Multiple Property National Register nomination.
- The locally designated Cold Spring Farm house (2000 Castle Gardens Road) is also for sale. N. Versaggi on behalf of the Commission wrote to John Farrell of Exit Realty and Penny Pelletier of Warren Real Estate to inform them that the property was designated as a local historic landmark in 2012 and is also eligible for listing on the State and National Registers of Historic Places. The Commission offered further information and assistance if there are questions about historical designations.

## New Business:

- Sexual harassment training is required of Town of Vestal employees and volunteers. Tentative date set for Commission members to take the training is August 19, 2019.
- The Commission is preparing a National Register Nomination form for the historic Jones Roth Farm. The NR form requires:
  - Full description of house, barn and outbuildings;
  - Photographs of all structures;
  - Mapping of property;
  - Statement of significance;
  - Census work to find farm output of products;
  - Context statements - look at writings by author Sally McMurray and her research on Pennsylvania farms and families for background of rural life in the 19<sup>th</sup> century.
