W. G. Pomeroy Foundation has established a new program for Canal markers. Vestal has two markers for the Chenango Canal extension that are in poor condition and need to be replaced. M. Hadsell spoke with Paula Miller, Director of the Pomeroy Foundation, and was informed that the Commission may apply for new markers in January 2019.

New Business

An October 11th conference call between Julian Adams, Bureau Director of the division of Historic Preservation of New York State, M. Hadsell and P. Deeley was reviewed. The purpose of the call was to discuss the process for tax credits on the Rounds House/Muench building repairs.
