## **Old Business:**

- Canal markers have been installed at the Front Street and Rivercrest locations.
- Jones Roth nomination:
  - The State Historic Preservation Office agreed to review a draft of the nomination form and offer their advice/recommendations on eligibility;
  - If it is not National Register eligible, it still could be eligible for listing on the State Register.
  - SHPO sent an example of a nomination of a farmstead in Delaware County for our use as a guide.
- More research needed to track the transition from lumber business to dairy farm at the Jones farm.
- Commission will continue work on nomination of Jones Roth Farm.

## **New Business:**

- CLG Annual Report due December 10, 2019
- William G. Pomeroy Foundation may have a Farm Marker program. This would be a possibility for the Jones Roth Farm. If the program is implemented, we may be able to nominate the farm for a historic marker in 2020.
