### **Rivercrest**

No updates at this time. As yet, only park facilities have been proposed for the property.

### **301 N. Main Street, Vestal (Rounds House)**

An inspection of the repair work was completed on March 18, 2020 by Commission members, Versaggi, Hadsell and Deeley. They noted that repairs were in compliance with the guidelines suggested by the Commission.

Due to COVID-19 and Gov. Cuomo's directives, construction was suspended. A Commission member will drive by to see if work has resumed.

### **Vestal Museum Relocation**

No date has been set to move the structure. A climate control trailer will be needed to house furniture and collections during the move.

### **Blue Lustron House on Vestal Parkway**

Potential buyers have contacted N. Versaggi and M. Hadsell for information concerning the restoration of the Lustron house. The interested party was given guidance on information available to assist in further research.

### **Nomination for Clay Street Lustron House**

Already designated as a local landmark, the owner of the Clay Street home has requested an application for nomination to the National Register of Historic Places. Under the multiple property documentation, the structure is already eligible. M. Hadsell and A. Jablonski will work on the nomination form.
