

# VISIBILITY AT INTERSECTIONS

## Chapter 24, Article VII, Division 1, Section 24-702. Visibility at intersections.

On corner lots, clear vision shall be maintained within the triangular area formed by the intersecting street lines and a straight line joining the street lines at points which are twenty (20) feet distance from the point of intersection, measured along such street lines. In such areas no shrubry, fence or other obstruction shall be permitted higher than three (3) feet from the accepted street grade, nor shall branches or foliage be permitted less than ten (10) feet from the ground.
