

Minutes of the Town of Vestal Historic Preservation Commission 9 December 2013

The meeting of the Commission was called to order at 7:05p.m. by M. Hadsell.

New Business:

- **Preparation of the Annual CLG Report to the New York State Parks Service** – A review of the Commission's work for the reporting period of October 1, 2012 through September 30, 2013 was completed and responses composed in preparation for submitting the annual online report.
- **Historic Marker Applications for 2014** – The approved timeframe for recognizing historic places has been expanded to 1750-1900. In January three applications will be prepared for submission to the William G. Pomeroy Foundation for the blue and yellow NYS style historic markers; they are: Chugnutt (1779), the Rounds House (1895), and the Vestal Center United Methodist Church (1875).
- **Commission Members** – The Commission is still seeking a local architect to fill the open position on the Commission. Susan Halpern, whose term is up at the end of 2013, has agreed to serve another term.

Old Business:

- **Historic Marker Grant Update** - Four William G. Pomeroy Foundation historic markers were installed by the Vestal Highway Department in November at: Drovers Inn, LaTourette Farm/Cold Spring Farm, the Mersereau House, and Rounds Cemetery.

The owner of the LaTourette Farm requested the relocation of the marker which was done.
