
Digital Literacy Classes

Mobile Dental Hygiene Services of Western Mass, LLC

Mobile Dental Hygiene Services of Western Mass is now at the Ware Senior Center and looks forward to assisting you with your dental needs. You may already be receiving dental care at your own dental office. If so, we recommend you continue with that care. If you do not have a dentist you see on a regular basis this is an opportunity for you to receive dental hygiene care.

Mobile Dental Hygiene Services of Western Mass is an on-site dental health service. The services offered are blood pressure screenings, dental screenings, oral cancer screenings, dental education , teeth cleaning and polishing, removable appliances (dentures) inspected and cleaned in an ultrasonic bath, fluoride treatments and assistance with finding a dental office.

MassHealth Dental Insurance will be billed for services provided when applicable. All billing will be at the end of the day that treatment was provided. All patients will receive a treatment sheet indicating what services were provided and for what value. Private pay patients must make payments at the time of service by cash or checks payable to Mobile Dental Hygiene Services of Western Mass, LLC.

Resolutions to grievances are sought with all parties involved. An "Employee Warning Notice" system may be part of the required corrective action process.

If your concern was not addressed to your satisfaction, you may contact WestMass ElderCare at 413-538-9020 for information regarding filing a written complaint. WestMass ElderCare has established formal Grievance Procedures for individuals who are dissatisfied with or denied services under Title III of the Older Americans Act. You must file your complaint within twenty (20) business days of the adverse action.
