

Waupaca County Curbside Recycling Guidelines

Plastic

ACCEPT:

- All plastic bottles & containers
- Household bottles, jars & jugs
- Dairy & take-out containers & lids

DO NOT ACCEPT:

- Plastic bags, wrap or film
- Motor oil bottles
- Styrofoam



Empty, rinse & replace caps & lids

Paper

ACCEPT:

- Newspaper, inserts & junk mail
- Cardboard & paperboard (food boxes)
- Milk, juice & soup cartons
- Office & school paper
- Phonebooks, soft cover books & magazines

DO NOT ACCEPT:

- Pet food bags
- Tissue paper & gift wrap
- Shredded paper



*Do not bundle & tie
Flatten & cut boxes to 2 ft x 2 ft*

Metal & Glass

ACCEPT:

- Aluminum bottles & cans
- Steel & tin cans
- Food & beverage bottles & jars

DO NOT ACCEPT:

- Aluminum pans or foil
- Aerosol cans
- Scrap metal
- Window glass
- Ceramics, china & drinking glasses



Empty & rinse

Recycling must remain loose & placed in a reusable container
NO Ties or Bags!

- **Bulky waste disposal:** Construction debris, furniture, toilets, mattresses, shingles, etc.
