Applications will be accepted for 10 business days; the application deadline for Alderman, Ward 3 is 5 p.m. on Friday, Feb. 23.

To qualify for Alderman, Ward 3, applicants must be:

- 18 years of age
- A citizen of the United States
- An inhabitant and resident of Ward 3 for one year next preceding the application date at the time he/she applies and during the time he/she serves as Alderman, Ward 3
- A qualified voter under the laws and constitution of this state and the ordinances of this City
- And shall not be in arrears for any unpaid City taxes or municipal user fees

Any person appointed to fill the vacancy will serve until a candidate is elected at the next regular municipal election, which will be held on April 3, 2018, and is thereafter sworn-in as an Alderman for Ward 3.
