Each year, Missouri Employers Mutual (MEM) recognizes employers for providing a safe work environment for the workers of Missouri. The process to select these "safe places to work" includes a nomination process by MEM, followed by a review board evaluation.

We are proud to announce that this year the City of Wentzville was one of the 18 employers recognized out of MEM's 15,000 insured policy holders in Missouri. The City was recognized for a number of reasons including its outstanding safety committee, above-average claims-management practices, the City's proactive efforts to spread a culture of safety through all City departments, and its ongoing commitment to safety.

The City's safety record has also earned the City an e-mod rating of .68, which means that the organization is paying 32 percent less on insurance premiums than other businesses and municipalities in Missouri. This savings translates into a \$30,252 return premium for this year.

"While this effort toward safety saves the City money, it also does the most important thing – ensures everyone goes home safely each night!" said Mayor Nick Guccione.
