The City of Wentzville invites community stakeholders to review the draft 2021-2026 General State Operating Permit MO-R04C000 for its Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System (MS4), as proposed by Missouri Department of Natural Resources, and the current Wentzville Stormwater Management Program (SWMP) prior to permit renewal. Your comments will help shape the development and implementation of the City's 2021-2026 SWMP.

Permit Authority: The state Clean Water Law, Chapter 644, RSMo, Missouri Clean Water Commission regulation 10 CSR 20-6.010 and federal Clean Water Act regulates stormwater discharges to waters of the state from regulated MS4s. The MS4 permit requires permittees to implement and enforce a Stormwater Management Program, and implement Best Management Practices via an iterative process to reduce the discharge of pollutants to the maximum extent practicable, for the goal of attainment with Missouri's Water Quality Standards (10 CSR 20-7.015 and 7.031). The Missouri Department of Natural Resources proposes to reissue permits October 2021, pending public comment. In accordance with draft permit guidelines, permittees shall revise their SWMP within 90 days after permit renewal to address new regulatory requirements. Based on the projected census, the City anticipates designation as Category C (Section 1.1.C).
