HOLIDAY NIGHT LIGHTS 16TH ANNUAL LIGHT DISPLAY

This annual light display will be sure to add sparkle to your holidays. The mile-long display is open to visitors Thursdays through Sundays through December 8. Beginning December 12 through December 30 the display will be open every night except for Christmas Day on December 25. The display hours are 6-10:00pm. Admission is \$8 for vehicles holding up to 6 passengers. Vans and buses or vehicles holding more than 7 passengers will pay an additional \$1 per person, beginning with the seventh person.

Each year a special walk-thru night is held for those wishing to view the lights while strolling through the park. This event will be held on December 9, from 6-8:00pm. Visitors can meet with Santa and enjoy refreshments in the Kolb building. Admission is \$3 per person for ages six and up. Children five and under will be admitted free.

Holiday Trash Schedule

The trash pickup schedule will be adjusted to accommodate the **Christmas** and **New Years** Holidays. Monday & Tuesday pickups will occur on their regular schedule. Wednesday through Friday pickups will run one day later than normal. Wednesday pickups will take place on Thursday, Thursday pickups on Friday ending with Friday pickups on Saturday.

Winter Storm Procedures



Wentzville follows specific procedures to ensure that residents can travel roadways as soon as possible. First major roads such as Wentzville Pkwy are cleared. Once major roads are passable collector roads like Meyer Road and Mexico Road are cleared. Subdivision collector roads are cleared next and after that individual subdivision streets are cleared.

To enable plows to clear streets more efficiently residents are asked to move vehicles off the street. Cars left on streets and cul-de-sacs present major issues for snowplow crews and in some instances streets must be left unplowed.
