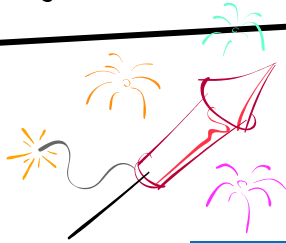

Irrigation System Backflow test reports are due **June 1**. Devices need to be tested by a State Certified Backflow Tester. A list of certified testers can be found on the City's web site. Send tests to Public Works or call (636) 327-5102 for more information.

SOLICITORS LICENSE

All solicitors are required to obtain a badge from the City Clerk's office. The solicitor is to wear the badge on the front of his/her outer garment in such a way as to be conspicuous. A solicitor is a person who attempts to make personal contact with a resident at his/her residence without prior specific invitation or appointment from the resident for the primary purpose of attempting to sell a good or service. Also a person who distributes handbills or flyers for a commercial purpose, advertising an event, activity, good or service that is offered to the resident for purchase at a location away from the residence or at a time different from the time of visit. If you have individuals or groups coming to your home or you see them in your neighborhood and they are not wearing a badge, please contact the Wentzville Police Department at (636) 327-5105.



Hazardous Waste Drop-Off

Hazardous household waste will be accepted May 1-September 30 at **Recycle Works- Central** (RWC) on Tuesday through Friday and the last Saturday of each month from 9:00am to 3:00pm. RWC is a St. Charles County facility and is located at 60 Triad South Drive, St. Charles, 63304. Limits to items dropped off may apply and proof of county residency is required. **Recycle Works-West**, located at 2110 E. Pitman Avenue in Wentzville, also accepts other recyclables (not including household waste).
