Staying Cool this Summer

St. Louis-area summers are hot! These summer heat waves present an unsafe environment to people, animals and infrastructure.



A heat wave is an extended period of extreme heat, and is often accompanied by high humidity. These conditions can be dangerous and even life-threatening if you don't take the proper precautions. You can work to prevent heat-related illnesses by following these tips:

- Drink more fluids, regardless of your activity level.
- Stay indoors, and, if at all possible, in an air-conditioned place. If your home does not have air-conditioning, go to the mall, a public library or a Cooling Center.
- Wear light-weight, light-colored, loose-fitting clothing. Never leave anyone or any pets inside a closed, parked vehicle.
- Extra precautions should be taken for infants and young children, people ages 65 and older, and people with mental or physical disorders.

As needed, Wentzville sets up Cooling Centers. When these centers are enacted, the City will make announcements on our website and Facebook pages. Visit bit.ly/MOCoolingCenters to locate a center nearby.
