Be a Good Fire-Pit Neighbor

Fire pits can be a source of warmth and ambiance. But, with the popularity of fire pits increasing, fire safety has become even more important. There are many things you should consider while setting up and using a fire pit. Below are rules to follow when installing and operating your backyard fire pit.

- Select the proper style of fire pit. It should be one made for recreation, with screening on all sides and on the top.
- Position the pit at least 15 feet away from any structure and make sure a fire extinguisher is nearby.
- Only burn clean, dry wood in your fire pit. Never use it to burn trash, construction material or green wood.
- Keep it away from gasoline/diesel, kerosene and charcoal lighter fluid, and vehicles while in use.



- Use the same precautions you would with an open fire.
- Don't let children use the pit; and keep pets away.
- Before starting the fire, ensure the lid will close to extinguish the fire in an emergency.
- Before you light the fire, check the wind direction.
- If the fire gets out of control, call 911 immediately.
