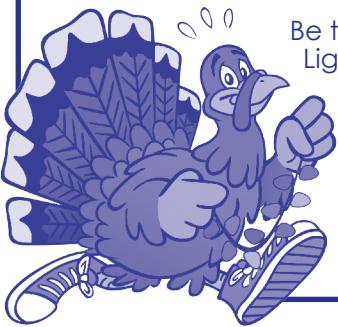
This program, initiated by the Mayor and City staff, highlights the difference just a few cents can make.
