

OPEN SESSION

The Board of Assessors met on Tuesday, April 27, 2021, at approximately 3:02 PM. Present were Chairman Steve McCarthy, Clerk Cheryl Smith, and Principal Secretary Daniela Nilsson. Member Paula Bunker was running late and Principal Assessor John Donahue was unable to attend. Due to the COVID-19 pandemic the meeting was closed to the public. However, the public was allowed to listen to the meeting via teleconference and to view a recording of the meeting via community access television.

The Chairman announced that the meeting was being recorded by community access television. He stated that in addition to paperwork needing signatures, the meeting was called this afternoon so the Board could meet in Executive Session to act on abatement applications.

Warrants and Bills Payable, Motor Vehicle Excise Abatement Certificates, Real/Personal Tax Abatements/Exemption applications/Certificates or Denials, Property Tax Deferral Applications/Certificates, Monthly Lists for Motor Vehicle, Statutory Exemption, and Real Estate Abatements were presented for signatures.

A **motion** was made by Chairman McCarthy to adjourn the Open Session and to enter into Executive Session in order to Review Applications for Abatement/Exemption/Classification, relative to Purpose 7, MGL CH 59, section 60, and to review and discuss strategy of pending Appellate Tax Board Cases, relative to Purpose 3 and 7, MGL CH 59, section 60 and not to reconvene in Open Session at the conclusion of the Executive Session. The motion was seconded by Clerk Smith. A **roll call vote** was taken as follows: Chairman McCarthy = affirmative, Clerk Smith = affirmative. The Board adjourned Open Session and entered Executive Session at approximately 3:04 P.M.
