The meeting was called to order at 5:30 P.M.

Ms. Simpson makes a motion to approve the minutes of January 26, 2021. Mr. Piesco 2nds.

Septic Plans

42 Hartshorn Street – Septic Upgrade

1. Ms. Simpson makes a motion to approve the local upgrade to decrease the separation to ground water from 4 to 3 feet to reduce grading and surface water impacts, Mr. Piesco 2nds
2. Ms. Simpson makes a motion to approve the use of a grain size analysis in lieu of a perc test to determine the loading rate, Mr. Piesco 2nds.
3. Ms. Simpson makes a motion to approve the reduction in vertical separation between groundwater and tees from 12 inches to 4 inches, due to high groundwater, Mr. Piesco 2nds.
4. Ms. Simpson makes a motion to approve the plans, Mr. Piesco 2nds. All Motions Passed.

62 Union Street –Previously approved on January 12, 2022. Plans presented show a change in a single tank to a two (2) compartment tank.
