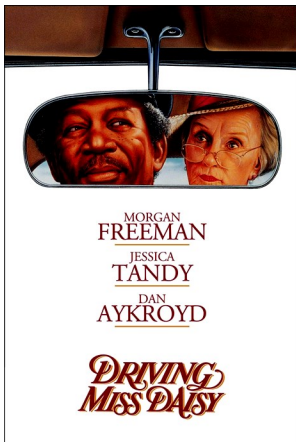

- Income and Social Security Cards for all members of the household.
- Photo ID for the head of household.
- Rental agreement /Lease,
- Copy of mortgage statement and/or property taxes & insurance.
- Current electric, water and heating bills.
