OUTDOOR POOL RULES

Please Read Before Entering Pool

- Proper swim suits required. Cut off shorts are not permitted.
- Children **12 years & under** **MUST** be accompanied by an adult at least 18 years of age or older. Adult must remain in pool area.
- Children with floatation devices must be accompanied in the water by an adult.
- Excessive public displays of affection are not permitted.
- Anyone acting in a manner that could cause harm to themselves or others will be dismissed from the facility.
- Any persons with an infectious disease or open sores will not be permitted in the pool.
- No breath holding training.
- No persons under the influence of drugs or alcohol will be permitted.
- **Unscheduled** Birthday parties or Camp visits will not be permitted.
- No outside coaching.
- Swim diapers required.

The following articles are NOT permitted in the pool area:

- Glass Containers
- Sharp Articles
- Loud Radios
- Outside Food or Drink
- Alcoholic Beverages
- No Smoking
- No Diving (only feet first entries)
- No Horseplay In Or Out Of The Pool
- Animals
- Tobacco Products
- Weapons
- Coolers
- Large Rafts
- No Running On Deck
- No Diapers In Pool
- No Gum

Patrons will be dismissed from the facility for the following reasons:

- Improper Conduct
- Causing injury to others
- Faking a drowning
- Intoxication
- Improper swim wear
- Failure to obey rules
- Failure to obey lifeguard
