



The Spring Recital is offered to all dancers currently registered in a "year-long" Rhythm & Spirit class. We encourage all students to participate in the recital, however it is not mandatory. Participating students will perform in 1 dance per class, as well as the finale.

👉 Commitment: Please note that all students who register MUST participate in the MANDATORY dress rehearsal in order to perform at recital -- there are no exceptions to this policy, including but not limited to high school graduations, other school/sports related events, or social events/gatherings.

💰 All Inclusive Fee: The recital fee covers everything – from Event Rental fees, a digital copy of the recital, t-shirt for each registered dancer, and their costume (yours to keep!) -- dancers participating in multiple classes will receive information via email regarding details on how to purchase their additional recital costume(s).

👗 Costumes: In an effort to ensure that costumes are delivered in time for (optional) individual dancer photos and allow for an organized distribution to our students, costume orders are placed prior to the December break. Costume manufacturers do NOT accept cancellations or offer refunds; therefore we are unable to refund any costume payments.

- Costume selection(s) pictured on each class sizing sheets are tentative and subject to change based on availability at the time the order is placed.
- During recital registration process, you will be required to select a costume size. Measuring tools such as measuring tape and a leotard sizing set for dancers to try on will be available at each studio to aid you in selecting the correct size. ******NOTE - it's recommended to add 1.5" to 2" to the girth measurement to account for growth (especially for little ones' growth spurts). If dancers are between sizes, select the size that most closely corresponds to the girth measurement. And when in doubt, size up as recital is still 7-months away!**
- Allow for growth when selecting costume size - It is easier, cheaper, and less complicated to alter a costume that is too large vs. too small. Any alterations that must be made are the responsibility of the guardian and cannot change the overall look of the costume.

🌟 REMEMBER 🌟 - you must select costume size during registration ; be sure to utilize the measuring tools available outside all studio locations and write down the size your dancer needs before beginning this process!! The size charts provided are specific to the costume company & should be used for reference -- **do NOT guess on sizing.**

How to Register for Recital:

📱💻 You may register and pay with a credit card (transaction fees apply) on your computer/phone OR with cash, check, or credit card (transaction fees apply) at one of our facilities with a front desk staff member. *If registering online, follow the instructions below based on your scenario -

Select "Add to Cart & Continue Shopping" with your additional costume link/activity number <u>provided to you via email</u> 3. Complete steps 1-4 (again) for additional costume 4. Select "Proceed to Shopping Cart" and complete payment

Tickets:

🎫 Ticket sales are limited to ensure every dancer is able to have audience members in attendance to watch their performances. Ticket sales are scheduled to take place in the spring, and are NOT included in the recital fee.

- All tickets are only sold online (purchased tickets may be printed or presented on mobile device)
- Tickets will not be on sale the day of recital.
- All audience members are required to have a ticket (with the exception of infants and small children who will be sitting in your lap throughout the full duration of the show).

Recital Q & A's:

❓ **Question: After registering, when will I receive more information regarding rehearsal & recital?**

💬 **Answer:** We will send out the Recital Information Packet in the Spring -- this will include costume care, detailed schedules for each day, and all policies & procedures for both dress rehearsal & recital.

❓ **Question: Will there be an option to purchase professional individual or class photos of my child?**

💬 **Answer:** Yes, class photos will be taken at Dress Rehearsal and can be purchased at Recital. We will send out information in the Spring regarding dates/times available to sign-up for individual photos.

❓ **Question: During recital can my child leave after their performance?**

💬 **Answer:** No, as part of our commitment to safety and ensuring a pleasant performance experience for all, we require all dancers remain in the student center throughout the entire duration of the recital.

❓ **Question: Can I visit my child in the Student Center during the recital?**

💬 **Answer:** No, as part of our commitment to safety access to the student center will be limited to WCPR staff, R&S Instructors, and parent volunteers. Information on how to sign-up to be a class parent volunteer will be available in the Recital Information Packet.
