The Rhythm & Spirit Spring Recital is offered for all dancers who are currently registered for a Rhythm & Spirit class. We encourage all dancers to participate in the recital, however it is not mandatory. Participating dancers will perform in 1 dance per class as well as the finale.

### **COMMITMENT & COST**

The recital registration deadline is **Saturday, October 23<sup>rd</sup>**. No exceptions. The recital fee of **\$110** is non-refundable and due at the time of registration. This recital fee includes the cost of 1 costume, a digital copy of the recital, an anniversary t-shirt, and event rental fees. Dancers participating in multiple classes will receive information through email regarding how to purchase their additional costume(s). Some classes may require the purchase of additional shoes for the recital.

### **COSTUMES**

You will be required to select a costume size at the time of registration. Please select your size carefully as **costumes cannot be returned, exchanged or replaced**. Measuring tools will be available at each studio to assist you in choosing your size. There will be a leotard sizing set with samples that can be tried on as well as measuring tape to find the best fit. If your child falls between 2 sizes or is close to the next size up, we recommend choosing the larger size. Sample tights are also available for choosing the best flesh tone for your dancer.

Please allow for growth as the recital is in May. It is easier, cheaper, and less complicated to alter a costume that is too big than one that is too small. Any alterations that must be made are the responsibility of the guardian and cannot change the overall look of the costume. Coordinators, instructors and front desk staff cannot assist with measurements or choosing a size as you know your child and their rate of growth best.

*\*\*Costume selections pictured on your class sizing sheet are tentative based on the availability at the time the order is placed.*

### **HOW TO REGISTER FOR RECITAL**

You may register and pay with a CREDIT CARD (transaction fees apply) on your computer / phone or with CASH, CHECK or CREDIT CARD (transaction fees apply) with a front desk staff member in our facilities.

1. Before starting registration, use the measuring tools and have your costume size selection ready. \*The size charts provided are specific to the costume company and should be used for reference. Do not guess on sizing.
2. Follow the registration link for your dancer's class online.
3. Select "Add To Cart."
4. Select the name of the student participating in the recital.
5. Answer ALL sizing questions.
6. Select "Proceed to Shopping Cart" and complete payment

OR

\* Select "Register Another Participant for this Activity" if you have more than 1 child participating in the recital in the same class.

\*\* Select "Add to Cart & Continue Shopping" with your next link / activity number if you have more than 1 child participating in the recital in a different class.

\*\*\*Select "Add to Cart & Continue Shopping" with your Additional Costume link / activity number if you have 1 child participating in the recital with multiple classes.

### **GENERAL POLICIES & INFORMATION**

-Dress rehearsal is **mandatory** for all dancers participating in the recital. No exceptions. Dancers who do not participate in dress rehearsal for any reason will not be allowed to participate in the recital.

-Class photos will be taken during dress rehearsal.

-Dancers will remain backstage for the **FULL** duration of the recital. No exceptions.

-Only WCPR staff, instructors, and volunteers will be permitted backstage for the full duration of the recital.

-Pictures and video are only allowed during dress rehearsal. Electronic devices are not permitted during the recital.

-The 2022 Recital Handbook will be sent out in the spring. This handbook will include all policies & procedures for dress rehearsal & recital, detailed schedules for each day, costume care, etc.

### **TICKETS**

Ticket sales will take place in the spring. Tickets are not included in the recital fee. Seating will be limited. More details regarding tickets sales and limits will be sent at a later date.
