SPLASH PARK RULES

Please Read Before Entering

- Children 12 years and under **MUST** be accompanied by an adult at least 18 years of age or older. Adult must remain in Splash Park area.
- No running or disorderly behavior
- Proper swim wear is required. (Swim suits and swim trunks)
- Swim Diapers are required for infants and children in diapers. Swim diapers available at Cashier office.
- Do not drink Splash Pad water
- Excessive public displays of affection are not permitted
- Anyone acting in a manner that could cause harm to themselves or others will be dismissed from the property.
- Any persons with an infectious disease or open sores will not be permitted in the Splash Park area.
- No food or drinks allowed on “WET ZONE” of the Splash Park.
- No soap.
- Do not climb, pull or hang on the equipment.
- No persons under the influence of drugs or alcohol will be permitted.
- **Unscheduled** Birthday parties or Camp visits will not be permitted.
- Swim diapers required.

The following articles are **NOT** permitted in the pool area:

- Glass Containers
- Sharp Articles
- Loud Radios
- Outside Food or Drink
- Alcoholic Beverages
- No Smoking
- No Diving (only feet first entries)
- No Horseplay In Or Out Of The Pool
- Animals
- Tobacco Products
- Weapons
- Coolers
- Large Rafts
- No Running On Deck
- No Diapers In Pool
- No Gum

Patrons will be dismissed from the facility for the following reasons:

- Improper Conduct
- Causing injury to others
- Faking a drowning
- Intoxication
- Improper swim wear
- Failure to obey rules
- Failure to obey Staff
